

# The McCoy Pedestal Table



A thick round top sits nicely on a pedestal. It must be thick enough to cantilever off the base and appear to float in the air. Therefore, we build these tops from our select 2" thick boards. Laying out a round top for a pleasing match of figure is a puzzle. The length of the shorter boards is a function of the width of the longer ones and the diameter of the top. The curving edge of the top should complement, not compete with, the figure of the wood.

## Options

- You may choose the wood.
- You may choose the diameter from 40" to 64." Smaller diameter tables have a smaller base.
- You may choose from three edge treatments.
- You may choose the preparation of the top: sanded or hand-planed.
